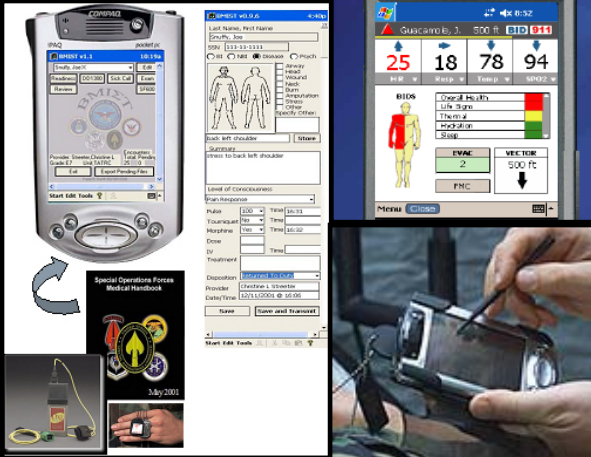

Battlefield Medical Information System – Tactical (BMIST)

OVERVIEW

BMIST is a point-of-care handheld assistant that enables healthcare providers to record, store, retrieve, and transmit essential medical information in an operational setting.

POTENTIAL USES

BMIST was designed for special forces and other first responders, but it has a variety of potential uses within the health care industry for collecting, storing, and transmitting patient data and critical medical information.

ADVANTAGES

- Allows rapid data entry
- Provides point of care references
- Uses commercial hardware
- Interface with handheld equipment
- Real time transmittal of data
- Entry of structured & free-field data.

DEVELOPMENT STATUS/OPPORTUNITY

BMIST is a fully functional software program. Thousands of units have been deployed and are in use. A US patent application for the technology is pending. The technology can be used as-is or modified for a particular use. Partners are sought for licensing, development & commercialization.
